We are looking for an enthusiastic and self-driven intern to provide support to The Code’s work relating to ‘implementation’ and to be a part of our small, but dynamic team and help us further strengthen the expansion and implementation of The Code of Conduct for Protection of Children from Sexual Exploitation in Travel and Tourism (“The Code”).

Job Description

- Assist the Project Manager to implement Code activities in Myanmar;
- With the Project Manager, help to recruit new companies in Myanmar and provide feedback on strategies for implementation within Myanmar;
- Provide implementation support to potential members in Myanmar;
- Help create materials in Burmese language for Code members and interested parties, as well as possible articles for social media;
- Help to promote best practices of companies and advocate for companies using The Code as a CSR or responsible tourism tool;
- Assist with translations of documents and best practices.

Skills Required

- Strong written and spoken communication skills in **Burmese** and English;
- Knowledge on the issue of commercial sexual exploitation of children and children’s rights, responsible tourism and CSR;
- Experience working with the tourism private sector;
- Experience working with governments and non-governmental organizations,
- Good team work and computer skills;
- Ability to self start with minimal supervision;
- Enthusiasm and dedication.

About “The Code”

In response to the phenomenon of child sex tourism, The Code of Conduct for the Protection of Children from Sexual Exploitation in Travel and Tourism (The Code, www.thecode.org) was initiated by the global child rights network ECPAT in cooperation with the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) and Scandinavian tour operators. Over the last 15 years, it has grown into a global initiative with more than 1000 travel companies from 42 countries having signed the Code. Today, it is one of the best examples of a voluntary sustainability standard for the protection of children’s rights.
